CHAIN-UP & CHAIN-OFF WINTER TRACTION PROCEDURE

CHAIN-UP: Preparation → Put Chains On → Roll & Adjust → Connect & Tighten → Bungees

STEP

1

CHAIN-UP

Install tire chains safely before driving on snow or ice

PHASE 1 — PREPARATION

1. Choose a safe place with no traffic to chain up.
2. Park straight on flat ground.
3. Set tractor and trailer brakes.
4. Put on safety vest.
5. Get tools: pliers, gloves, and chains.

PHASE 2 — POSITION CHAINS ON TIRE

1. Lay chains flat on the ground behind the drive tires (correct chain type for your tire configuration).
2. Drape chains evenly over the top of the tire.

PHASE 3 — ROLL THE TRUCK ONTO CHAINS

1. Get in cab.
2. Release tractor and trailer brakes.
3. Move truck forward slowly roll onto the chains.
4. Stop the truck.
5. Set tractor and trailer brakes.
6. Get out of cab.

PHASE 4 — CONNECT & TIGHTEN CHAINS

For Single/Double Chains:

- a. Connect inside rail.
- b. Connect outside rail.

CHAIN-UP & CHAIN-OFF PROCEDURE

For Triple Chains:

- a. Connect centre rail.
- b. Connect inside rail.
- c. Connect outside rail.

1. Tighten chains using a wrench ensure snug fit with no slack.
2. Put bungees on if needed to prevent chain slap.



CHAIN-UP REMINDER: Always wear gloves and a safety vest. Never drive with loose chains they can damage the truck and trailer. After driving 1–2 km, stop and re-tighten chains if needed.

CHAIN-OFF: Remove Bungees → Disconnect Rails → Lay Flat → Drive Off → Inspect & Store

CHAIN-OFF

Remove tire chains safely after clearing snow and ice

PHASE 1 — REMOVE BUNGEEES & DISCONNECT CHAINS

1. Remove bungees if they were used.

For Single Chains:

- a. Remove outside rail.
- b. Remove inside rail.

For Triple Chains:

- a. Remove outside rail.
- b. Remove inside rail.
- c. Remove centre rail.

PHASE 2 — LAY CHAINS FLAT & STORE TOOLS

1. Lay chains flat and straight on the ground behind the tires.
2. Put tools away.

PHASE 3 — DRIVE OFF CHAINS

1. Get in cab.
2. Release tractor and trailer brakes.

CHAIN-UP & CHAIN-OFF PROCEDURE

3. Drive forward slowly off the chains.
4. Stop the truck.
5. Set tractor and trailer brakes.
6. Get out of cab.

PHASE 4 — INSPECT & STORE CHAINS

1. Check chains for damage look for broken links, bent rails, or worn cross chains.
2. Store chains properly in their bag or designated storage location.



CHAIN-OFF REMINDER: Never leave chains on the road collect all hardware and bungees. Always inspect chains for damage before storing. Report any broken links or damaged hardware immediately.

QUICK REFERENCE SUMMARY

Chain-Up: Preparation → Drape Chains → Roll Onto Chains → Connect Rails → Tighten → Bungees

Chain-Off: Remove Bungees → Disconnect Rails → Lay Flat → Drive Off → Inspect → Store
